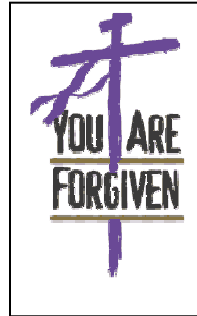

You can do this anytime up until Monday, November 23rd. The following is a suggested list for donations by last name (doing it this way enables a more even distribution of food collection):

- G-H** Stuffing, Cranberry Sauce
- I-J** Cookies, Cake or Brownie Mix
- K-L** Potatoes, fresh or dried
- M-Mc** Baked Beans, Rice, Cranberry Sauce
- N-O** Canned Vegetables
- P-Q** Canned Fruit, Stuffing
- R-S** Potatoes, fresh or dried, Stuffing
- T-U** Gravy (mixed or canned)
- V-W** Nuts, Raisins, Dried Fruit, Candied Vegetables
- X-Z** Canned Pumpkin, Evaporated Milk
