**Loaves and Fishes:** We will be preparing and serving **CHILI on Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>** at Christ Church Cathedral. If you would like to volunteer or need more information, please call Pren Boss at 736-4878. Please follow the recipe below:

### Simple Chili

This will serve 4 people. For the Soup Kitchen please triple it so it will serve 10 to 12.

$\frac{3}{4}$  lbs hamburger  
1 cup chopped onions (smaller amount optional)  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  cup green peppers chopped  
2 cloves of fresh garlic minced (smaller amount optional)  
1 (16 ounce) can of red kidney beans (drained)  
18 ounce can of tomato sauce  
2 teaspoons of chili powder  
 $\frac{1}{2}$  teaspoon of dried basil

$\frac{1}{4}$  teaspoon of salt and pepper

Cook hamburger, onions, garlic and green peppers together until meat is cooked ... drain fat. Add the rest of the ingredients, kidney beans, chili powder, dried basil, salt and pepper. Simmer for 20 minutes.

- Three construction firms have come back to look into converting the bowling alley to meeting space – we are still getting quotes. Will need architect. It should be possible to do it without making it handicap accessible (which would greatly increase cost).
- A lift has been built for the Alderman Street school building for handicap accessibility.
- Meeting with the Diocese on Thursday regarding finances.
- Pew count is the same as last year.
